Taking Courses

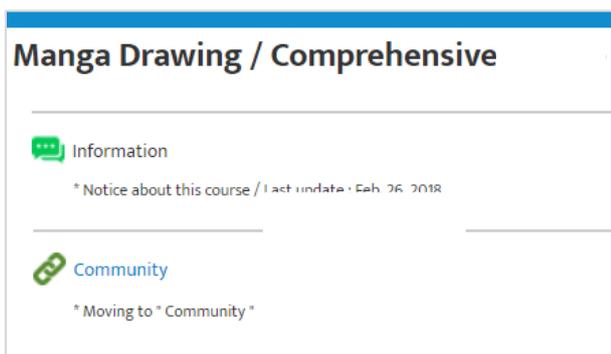
Taking courses in MANABI JOURNEY is very simple.

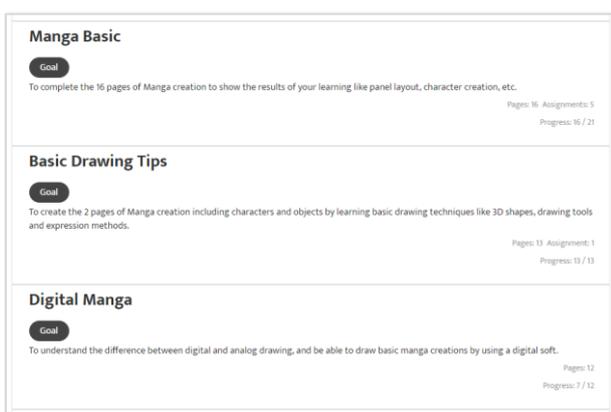

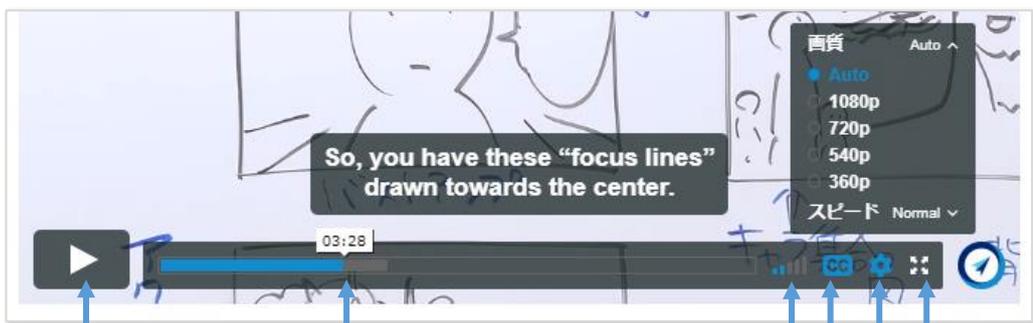

1. About Reviewing Tests and Corrections

All the MANABI JOURNEY courses have quizzes, tests and corrections. In this page you can find instructions on how to take tests and how to submit assignment corrections(*1). In some courses the progression rate(*2) doesn't go up because you did not obtain the passing score.

*1 About submitting correction assignments

You will need to submit assignment corrections in some of our "Manga Drawing Course" and convert them into digital format. You can only submit each of those once. Thank you for your understanding.

*2 About "progression rate"

Your course progression status is displayed on the "My Course" page as a percentage. When you reach 100%, a "Certificate" is issued.

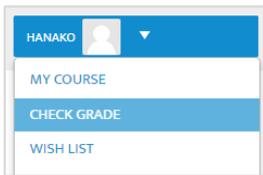
The results will be immediately displayed after finishing the tests.

We advise you to review the results, especially wrong answers.

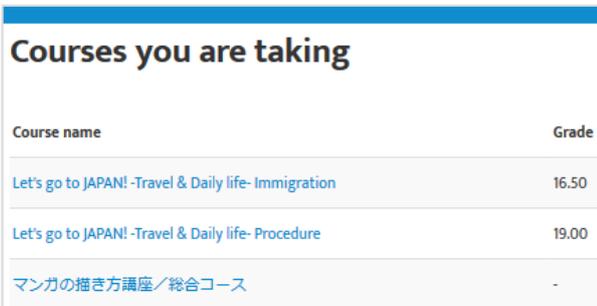
You can repeat the tests as many times as you want.

It's important to review your tests after you've finished them and learn from your mistakes. You should review not only the lesson videos, but also tests and correction results.

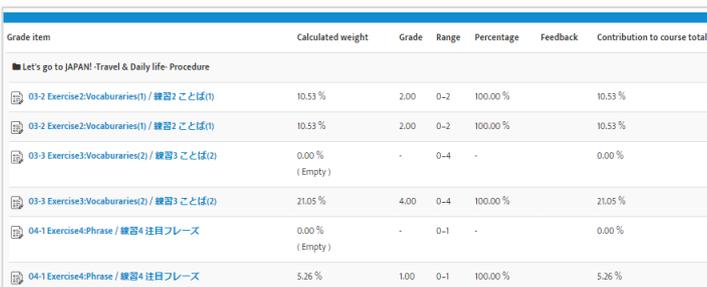

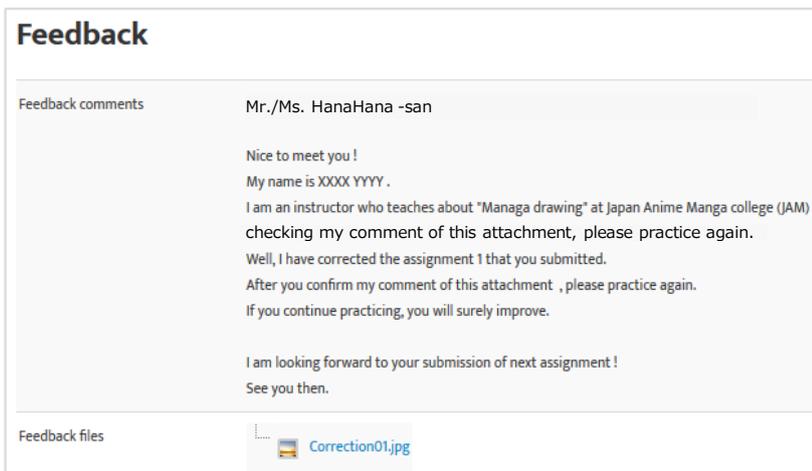

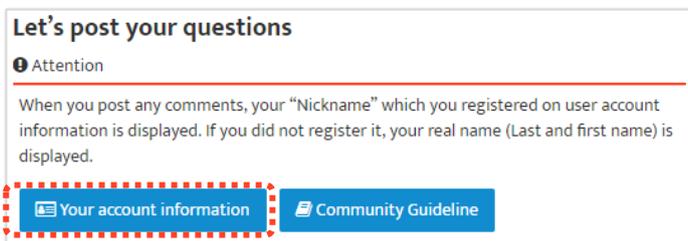
MANABI JOURNEY has a Social Network Community service offered to course members only. In here you can post questions and comments, share information and show your creations to other members.

(1) Searching

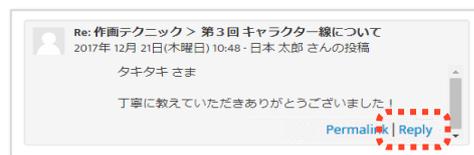
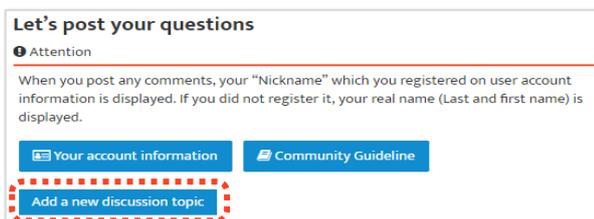
There are many topics already posted in the Community.
